



## **2017 National Garden Club Youth Sculpture Contest**

### **Contest Rules**

1. Children in 4<sup>th</sup> through 8th grade are eligible to enter the contest.
2. Sculptures must consist of recyclable, reused, and reduced materials.
3. The sculpture is limited to a size that would fit on a 8 ½" x 11" sheet of paper.
4. The height of the sculpture should be in proportion to the width.
5. Entries should include as many photographs as can be printed on the back of the entry form. Two 4 x 6 photographs are recommended.
6. Each entry must have a separate and completed form. See Entry form on page-2 of this document.
7. **Scale of Points:**
  - Creative use of materials and self-expression - 60 points
  - Description of sculpture and materials - 30 points
  - Craftsmanship and technique - 10 points
